Anzac Day and Remembrance Word Puzzle (Grades 1–3)

Purpose:

This word puzzle introduces young students to the ideas of remembrance, kindness, and helping others, using simple words and positive messages.

Curriculum Links:

Humanities and Social Sciences (History)

Civics and Citizenship

Personal and Social Capability

Key Learning Outcomes:

Students will:

Learn basic words connected to remembering and saying thank you

Begin to understand why Australians remember special days such as Anzac Day and Remembrance Day

Practice reading and word-finding skills

Teacher Guidance:

Begin with a short, simple discussion about remembering people who help keep us safe.

Read the clues aloud together if needed.

Remind students that this activity is about kindness, respect, and saying thank you.

Classroom Discussion Prompts:

What does it mean to remember someone?

How can we show respect to others?

Who are people that help our community?

Sensitivity Note:

Avoid detailed discussion of war or fighting. Focus on ideas of helping, caring, and remembering.
